This qualification reflects the role of workers in community and/or residential settings who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centered support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. These individuals take responsibility for their own outputs within the scope of their job role and delegation. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

Learners must successfully complete 120 hours of industry work placement to be awarded their qualification.
